## **Curriculum:**

The subject 'Environmental Education and Water Safety' is compulsory for the students of Arts, Commerce, Science, Higher Secondary Vocational Courses and all undergraduate courses in Junior College and the marks of this subject should be divided annually.

Project work 30 Marks

Journal/Seminar Work 20 Marks

Total = 50 Marks

## **Evaluation methods:**

- Mark obtained will be converted into A,B,C,D grade, D grade will indicate fail.
- Class 11-12 Environmental Education and Water Safety will be evaluated by internal and external examiners.
- The annual result of the students will be declared by converting the marks obtained by the students out of 50 from the combined examination of internal examiner and external examiner.
- Students should convert the marks obtained out of 50 in the subject of Environment Education and Water Safety of Class 12 to the Board in the official grade sheet. Although there is no written examination for this subject, project work and seminar/journal work will be converted out of 50 marks and the marks obtained will be shown in the mark sheet.

Passing in 'Environmental Education and Water Safety' is mandatory for passing in class 11<sup>th</sup> -12<sup>th</sup>.

- As there is no written examination for Environmental Education and Water Safety, there will be no revaluation of this subject.
- Concession marks will not be payable for environmental education and water safety.
- Once a student has passed in Environmental Education and Water Security, if he wants to re-admit for grade enhancement, he has to redo the project, journal/seminar work.
- Class 12<sup>th</sup> students should complete / write project work report and journal/seminar work only in the project and journal work book provided by the board.
